The Student Success Center provides the following services:

Academic Advising

Academic Advising at the Student Success Center is designed to facilitate a seamless transition into JSRCC. Advising Specialists provide academic support by assisting students with the clarification of their academic and curricular goals. Advising Specialists also interpret placement test scores, recommend courses for new students and returning non-curricular students, and assist students with registration and other enrollment processes. Students are strongly encouraged to meet with an advisor before registering for courses.

Financial Aid

The Student Success Centers are students first point of contact for information regarding the financial aid process at JSRCC. Financial Aid Specialists assist students by explaining the financial aid process, receiving requested documents, forwarding documents to the Office of Financial Aid for processing, conducting financial aid workshops, and answering inquiries related to student financial aid status.

Admissions

The Admissions Specialists in the Student Success Centers provide services to students associated with college admission procedures. Admissions Specialists assist students with the application process, receive requested domicile documents and forward them to the Office of Admissions and Records for processing, issue student verification of credit letters, and process enrollment requests.

Veterans Affairs

Eligible veterans who are entitled to receive certain educational benefits can speak with a Veterans Affairs Specialist. The Veterans Affairs Specialist can answer general benefit questions, assist students with the VA application process, and certify students for educational benefits.

Referrals

Success Center Specialists provide students with referrals to various services within the college. These services include financial aid, admissions, student accommodations, student life, transfer and career planning, and academic departments. Success Skills Workshops

Success Skills Workshops provide academic and personal enrichment to students in a variety of areas. *Stress Management, Time Management, and Becoming A Successful Student* are some of the workshops offered at all three JSRCC campuses. Financial Aid Workshops

Are you new to the financial aid application process? Do you find yourself asking: What does SAP mean? Am I eligible for financial aid? What is the difference between a grant and a loan? Orientation and Registration

All Success Center Specialists participate in new student orientation and registration programs such as SOAR (Student Orientation, Advising, and Registration) and Group Advising. At these sessions, students learn about success resources at the College; placement test score results are interpreted and questions related to academic programs, course requirements, class schedules, and JSRCC college policies are addressed.
