REYNOLDS TO OPEN GINTER PARK CENTER ON BROOK ROAD

RICHMOND, Va. (June 18, 2010)—J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College has leased three vacant buildings on the Union Theological Seminary campus in Ginter Park to use as swing space during an \$11 million renovation of its downtown campus on Jackson Street. The three-year lease agreement includes Lingle Hall and the Newbury Center on Brook Road, and Dubose Hall on Palmyra Avenue.

The seminary buildings provide 46,000 square feet of space that will be used for classrooms and faculty offices starting this fall. Reynolds is spending \$495,000 this summer to renovate the seminary buildings in time to have them open for classes this fall. The location will be known as the Ginter Park Center.

The Center will operate Monday -Thursday from 7 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. and Fridays from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The buildings will be closed on weekends. Administrative services will continue to operate from the main campuses. Students taking classes at the Ginter Park Center are encouraged to continue to park in the Downtown Campus parking deck and utilize the free shuttle service; however, a 200 space lot will be available on site.

Serving nearly 20,000 students annually, J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College is the youngest and third largest of 23 community colleges in Virginia. The College operates three campuses serving residents in the City of Richmond and the counties of Henrico, Hanover, Goochland, Powhatan and Louisa.

Union-PSCE (soon to be Union Presbyterian Seminary) offers graduate degree programs on campuses in Richmond, Va., and Charlotte, N.C. and through the Extended Campus Program (EXCP), to prepare men and women for Christian ministries. Founded in 1812, it is one of ten theological seminaries of the Presbyterian Church U.S.A.
