RICHMOND, Va. (January 8, 2010) – J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College has hired Susan Hunter, Ph.D. as the Dean of the School of Nursing and Allied Health. Dr. Hunter will oversee the College's programs that offer AAS or Certificate degrees in 11 different healthcare fields including registered nursing, dental assisting, respiratory therapy, and opticianry.

A native Virginian and graduate of Huguenot High School, Dr. Hunter comes to Reynolds after serving as the Dean of Allied Health at Quincy College in Quincy, Mass. She has also taught at Old Dominion University (ODU) in Norfolk, Va. and has held adjunct and online faculty positions at Quincy College, Tidewater Community College in Norfolk, Va., Axia, a subsidiary of Phoenix Online, and Davenport University in Grand Rapids, Mich.

Dr. Hunter has a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Theatre, Arts and Dance and a Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies with a focus on family services counseling – both from ODU; a Master of Science in Community Health Education from ODU; and a Ph.D. in Interdisciplinary Studies/Health Sciences from The Graduate College of The Union Institute and University in Cincinnati, Ohio.
