COMMUNITY IMPACT 2007-08

Student Population:

- Total number of students served since 1972 – 280,000
- Total number of students 2006-07– 18,059
- Full-time to part-time ratio – 24% to 76%

Preparing for the Future:

- 40% of Reynolds students are enrolled in transfer programs
- 60% of Reynolds students are enrolled in one of 50 technical career programs

Total Employee Workforce:

- Number of employees Fall 2007 – 1071

Impact of Counties/City Financial Support:

- \$47.5 million Total Budget
 - \$25 million from State= 52.5%
 - \$17 million from tuition/fees= 36%
 - \$3.5 million from other revenues= 7%
 - \$1.3 million from private donations and grants= 3%
 - \$0.7 million from local county/city governments= 1.5%

Tuition Comparison

- Average 2007-08 full-time in-state community college tuition and fees is \$2,404
- Average 2007-08 full-time in-state 4-year public institution tuition and fees is \$7,083 (Source: SCHEV)

Financial Impact:

- Graduates with an associate's degree earn about \$8,000 more a year than individuals without an associate's degree.
- Individuals with an associate's degree earn about \$250,000 more over the course of a career than those without an associate's degree.
- For every \$1 invested in J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, a sum of \$3 is returned to the Commonwealth.

Providing a Trained Workforce:

- The Community College Workforce Alliance (CCWA) provides training annually to over 14,000 individuals from more than 700 employers.

Advancing the Community:

- Reynolds graduates more than 200 nurses each year to help address the regional nursing shortage.
- More than 7,200 Reynolds students are in programs to transfer to 4-year colleges and universities.
