Credits: 2

Course Title: Automotive Vehicle Inspection

Course Description: Presents information on methods for performing automotive vehicle safety inspection. Lecture 1 hour. Laboratory 2 hours. Total 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: Present standards for vehicle state inspection, servicing, and procedures according to Virginia State Inspection Laws. Safety will be emphasized.

Upon completing the course, the student will be able to

- a. Describe state inspection requirements and demonstrate a vehicle inspection as required by state inspection laws;
- b. Describe servicing requirements and procedures for automobiles, light duty trucks, and heavy duty vehicles, and demonstrate those procedures as required by the manufacturers according to Virginia State laws; and
- c. Describe proper preventative maintenance procedures and demonstrate those procedures as required.
