**COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER:** SPA 202

**CREDIT HOURS:** 3

**COURSE TITLE:** Intermediate Spanish II

**PREREQUISITES:** SPA 201 or equivalent

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Continues to develop understanding, speaking, reading, and writing skills. May include one additional hour oral drill and practice per week. Lecture 3 hours per week.

#### **MAJOR TOPICS TO BE COVERED:**

- A. Complete study of subjunctive mood, adjective, adverbial clauses plus independent uses
- B. Review of frequently used expressions in Spanish
- C. Cultural readings of Latin American Countries

**GENERAL COURSE OBJECTIVES:** Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- A. Recognize the most significant aspects of Spanish life and culture through readings
- B. Demonstrate his ability to select creative material for reading, discussion and composition
- C. Apply further the reading and writing skills through compositions using usable vocabulary, concepts and verb forms
- D. Demonstrate his thought on the political and cultural issues through conversation
- E. Read with fluency from the textbook and outside readings
- F. Function at Intermediate to Advanced level of ACTFL Rating Scale - Mid Intermediate to High Intermediate
