About Reynolds Learning Communities

A learning community (LC) is when two courses in the same semester are strategically linked together and the same students enroll in both courses. This Fall Reynolds has paired up courses in several unique LCs to enrich student learning.

LC Benefits

- **Shared assignments and topics**—Instructors work to integrate assignments for crossover learning.
- **Convenient scheduling**—LC classes are typically scheduled back-to-back.
- **Support system**—The LC structure makes it easier to meet peers, make friends, and get assistance from professors.
- **And that's not all**—The linked courses can help you meet the requirements for your program at no additional cost!

How to Enroll

To enroll, follow these steps:

1. Review the descriptions on pages 2 through 3 and find the LC you would like to take.
2. Note the 5-digit course numbers for both LC courses.
3. In your Student Center, add both classes to your schedule. Here's how:
 - a. Click **Enroll**, then click **Add**.
 - b. Type the 5-digit number for Class #1, then click **Enter**.
 - c. Type the 5-digit number for Class #2, then click **Enter**.
 - d. Click **Proceed to Step 2 of 3**.
 - e. Click **Finish Enrolling**.

Ethics for Health Science Majors LC

This LC pairs Therapeutic Communication in the Healthcare Setting (HCT 110) and Ethics for Healthcare Personnel (HLT 145) in a new learning community for Health Science majors. Both classes are taught in a 16-week hybrid format, which blends on-campus face-to-face meetings with online activities and assignments, so basic computer skills are required.
