



MASTER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between  
SHENANDOAH CONSERVATORY  
A SCHOOL OF SHENANDOAH UNIVERSITY

and  
THE MUSIC PROGRAM AT  
J. SARGEANT REYNOLDS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Shenandoah University, a senior, private university, accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, hereby enters into a direct transfer agreement with J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, accredited by the Virginia Community College System.

For the purposes of this agreement, the direct transfer will apply to those graduates seeking to matriculate in the Conservatory of Shenandoah University. Students may transfer credits and be accorded privileges and benefits following evaluation by the Dean of the Conservatory.

A student who has met all requirements for admission to Shenandoah University and has a grade of "C" or better in music courses being transferred will be permitted to enroll in Shenandoah University with all privileges and benefits available to any other student accepted into the University, including eligibility for financial assistance, academic honors, student activities, and social opportunities.

A student transferring to Shenandoah University under this agreement shall have acceptance of academic credits earned at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College at face value as appropriate to the selected course of study at Shenandoah University and applied toward the completion of the degree.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all music courses transferred and a minimum GPA of 2.0.

The courses applicable for direct transfer are listed in the transfer offices of both institutions.

This agreement is self renewing and will be renewed and updated as changes in the curricula occur at each institution.


The specific articulation between the Conservatory of Shenandoah University and the Music Program of J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College is as follows:


1. Graduates of JSRCC with an Associate of Applied Arts in Music will be accepted at Junior status at the Conservatory in the Bachelor of Music in Performance-Wind, String, and Percussion concentrations.

2. JSRCC graduates in Performance in Voice and Piano may be required to take freshman and sophomore level courses not offered at JSRCC before Junior status is conferred.


3. JSRCC graduates wishing to enroll in Commercial Music or other Conservatory degree programs will be able to transfer credits by the course-by-course transfer guide contained in this agreement.
