

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS in MUSIC

Between
J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College (JSRCC)
And
Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU)


Purpose: This memorandum of understanding has been developed within the framework of the Virginia State Policy on Transfer to facilitate the transfer of students with the Associate of Applied Arts (A.A.A.) Degree in Music and music credits earned by students at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College into Bachelor of Music, B.M. (performance or education) or Bachelor of Arts, B.A. degree programs in music at Virginia Commonwealth University. It is intended to provide students, enrolled in the A.A.A. program (music) at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, admission into the music program at Virginia Commonwealth University. This agreement establishes a partnership between JSRCC and VCU for the benefit of students. This agreement updates and supersedes the Articulation Agreement between JSRCC and VCU signed on November 20, 1992.

1. JSRCC will advertise this program to the general public with special attention provided to the six school divisions within the JSRCC service area. This program will be promoted as the "Associate of Applied Arts in Music Transfer Degree Program" in the JSRCC Catalog, and in semester schedules of classes and other promotional materials. These materials will call attention to this articulation agreement between VCU and JSRCC for the Associate of Applied Arts Music Transfer Degree Program.
2. Courses listed in this program will be reviewed on an annual basis, or as needed, by the faculty of both institutions to ensure continuity of instruction, curriculum, and evaluation. The attached "Music Transfer Program Table" lists the respective transfer credits that will be awarded by VCU for courses offered by JSRCC students for transfer. This table will be updated as curricula evolve. While no specific value of maximum credit hours for transfer is defined, course equivalency and transfer credits should be limited to those courses shown for the specific major on the "Music Transfer Program Table."

3. VCU Department of Music will admit into its B.M. (performance or education) or B.A. programs (music) based upon a performance audition, music theory diagnostic and keyboard skill evaluation those students in the JSRCC transfer option who have completed the Associate of Applied Arts Degree in Music and who have a minimum curriculum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and no individual course grade lower than "C." Students with less than a 3.0 GPA will be considered on an individual basis.
4. VCU Department of Music will consider admission into its B.M. (performance or education) or B.A. programs (music) based upon a performance audition, music theory diagnostic and keyboard skill evaluation of JSRCC curricular Music A.A.A. program students who have not completed the A.A.A. program but who have attained a grade of "B" (or higher) for all courses listed on the attached "Music Transfer Program Table," or substitution courses mutually acceptable to both institutions, that are offered for transfer to VCU, and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students with less than a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 will be considered on an individual basis.
5. Transfer may occur at any time during the above-prescribed course of study at JSRCC. However, students are encouraged to complete the Music A.A.A. degree program prior to transfer.
6. In this articulation agreement there are no provisions made for "back transfer" credits from VCU to JSRCC. Future articulation agreements may contain the option for JSRCC students to be awarded the A.A.A. for students who have transferred after completing 75% of their course work at JSRCC and transferred to VCU to complete a B.M. (performance or education) or the B.A. In the future to facilitate this "back transfer," VCU will provide JSRCC with a list of all B.M. and B.A. graduates in music each year to ensure identification of all eligible students. Credits will be back transferred and the A.A.A. degree will be awarded by JSRCC.
7. VCU will cooperate with JSRCC in their development of additional courses in music, including the development and implementation of student portfolios and dual enrollment offered to JSRCC students. Such courses will be scheduled, offered and located as mutually agreed upon by VCU and JSRCC contingent upon the satisfactory completion of these plans.
