J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College has a STEM sub-award with Virginia Commonwealth University from the National Science Foundation to support a scholarship/academic support program. J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College has funds to support up to seven scholars per year at \$2500 a year (\$1250 per semester) for the 2010-2011 academic year.

To be eligible:

- Students must be in Mathematics, Engineering, Computer Science, Civil Engineering, or Computer Technology programs
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher
- Taking a full-load of coursework
- Participate in three hours per week in problem-solving activities in either MTH 173, MTH 174, or MTH 277
- Participants in this program must have need documented by FAFSA criteria
