Reynolds Community College honored as a Top 10 Digital College

RICHMOND, Va. (April 26, 2016) – Reynolds Community College was recently named one of the top 10 digital community colleges in a national survey by The Center for Digital Education (CDE). The survey analyzes how community colleges use a range of technologies to improve services to students, faculty, staff and the community at large.

Reynolds tied for 2nd place in the large college category for colleges with 10,000 students or more, tying with Howard Community College in Maryland.

Award winners demonstrated innovative uses of technology, including online courses and mobile environments, mobile apps, secure platforms and wireless networks.

The Center for Digital Education is a national research and advisory institute specializing in K-12 and higher education technology trends, policy, and funding.

All accredited U.S. community colleges are eligible to participate in the survey within three classifications based on size of enrollment.

Serving over 20,000 students annually, J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College is the youngest and third largest of 23 community colleges in Virginia. The College operates three campuses serving residents in the City of Richmond and the counties of Henrico, Hanover, Goochland, Powhatan and Louisa.
