Course Title: Bankruptcy

Course Description: Provides a practical understanding of non-bankruptcy alternatives and the laws of bankruptcy including Chapters 7, 11, 12, and 13 of the Bankruptcy Code. Emphasizes the preparation of petitions, schedules, statements, and other forms. Lecture 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: To teach the student in the general practice specialization alternatives to bankruptcy and how to prepare the forms and documents applicable to a bankruptcy proceeding.
