VA Work-study opportunity

The Veterans Resource Center is looking for work-study students for the summer and fall. You can get paid to work a part-time job while you study. The pay is \$11.00 per hour.

The VA-Work study student will provide front desk duties, such as answering phone calls, sending and receiving emails, answering questions, and assisting walk-in-students.

Assist with events that are sponsored by the Veterans Resource Center. As needed, assist students in registering for classes, applying for educational benefits, and performing other clerical office duties.

You qualify if you meet the following:

- You're enrolled at least three-quarter time in a college degree program.
- You're using an approved VA education benefits program to pay for your education.
- You can finish the work-study contract while you are still qualified for benefits.

Summer school full-time equivalency for Monthly Housing Allowance

If you are attending summer school, please use the chart below to determine how many credit hours you should enroll in to receive your full-time housing allowance. Remember, credit hours and the dates of enrollment are reported to the VA. ***The summer full-time equivalency does not have anything to do with what is required full-time for financial aid purpose or Reynolds Community College.*** 12 credit hours is still considered full-time during the summer.

Summer School

Nonstandard term	Full Time	¾ time
Regular Session (10 weeks)	7 credit hrs.	6 credit hrs.
Seven - Week Session	6 credit hrs.	4 credit hrs.
First Five – Week Session	4-5 credit hours	3 credit hrs.
Second Five – Week Session	4-5 credit hours	3 credit hrs.

GI Bill Recipients

On June 1, 2022, COVID-19 legislation that permits students to receive their Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) at the resident (in-person) rate while taking courses converted to online training will end.

As we are approaching the expiration of these provisions, it is important that the Department of Veteran Affairs (VA) emphasize that your institution must return to the approved modality on or before June 2, 2022, or you risk you will risk no longer receiving GI Bill benefits for their training.
