## Post – 9/11 Educational Assistance benefits Changes

As of August 1, 2021, Chapter 33 students must verify their enrollment status each month to continue receiving their monthly housing allowance (MHA) and /or kicker payments. This change will be implemented in phases, starting with students enrolled at Non Degree (NCD) facility.

Students are asked to verify their enrollment status relative to what the SCO has reported on their behalf. This is not attendance verification.

Student can verify their enrollment status in one of two ways:

1. Text messaging – student who choose VA’s “Opt-In” feature will receive a text message each month prompting them to verify their enrollment status
2. Telephone – students may call the Education Call Center (ECC) at [888-442-4551](tel:888-442-4551)
