## Chapter 33 GI Bill recipient students

In accordance with section 1019 of Public Law 116-315, **VA will not collect these debts from you.** Rather, VA will collect these amount from your school. In turn, your school will have you pay any outstanding balance for tuition and fees and will contact you regarding this debt. **It is important that you work with your school to resolve this matter.**

The VA will not collect tuition debt from you. However they will collect any debts associated with the monthly housing allowance and the books and supplies stipend.

## **When registering for classes please remember the course modalities/formats**

### **One in person class is needed to receive your full housing allowance**

**In person:** All instructional hours are taught in person, face-to-face. (PR, DT, GC, TK)

**Traditional Online:** Instruction hours are delivered online without any specific scheduled class meeting time. (OA)

**Live Online:** Instructional hours in real-time online through live video conferencing. (LO)

**Online Hybrid:** Instructional hours delivered online through a combination of live and traditional online format meetings. (HO)

**Hybrid in-person/Live online:** 50-99% of instructional hours delivered live, online and remaining instructional hours are in person, face-to-face. (LP, LD, LG, LK)

**Hybrid in-person/Traditional online:** 50-99% of instructional hours delivered in traditional online format and remaining instructional hours are delivered face-to-face. (HP, HD, HG, LK)

**Hyflex-Hybrid:** 50% of instructional hours delivered live (on - campus or via zoom) and 50% of course completed online through Canvas (or another digital learning platform)

## **VA work study program**

The Veteran Resource Center is looking for one to two students to work in the office during the summer. You may be eligible to take part in the work study program if you meet the requirements.

- Enrolled at least three-quarter time in a college degree.
- Can finish the work-study contract while you still qualify for education benefits
- Are using an approved VA education benefits program to pay for your education or training
