Preparing to get certified for your benefits

As we get ready to start spring 2021 semester, students are encouraged to get certified as soon as possible. After you register for your spring 2021 (2212) classes please submit your Request for Certification (RFC) as soon as possible. This form can be found on the Reynolds Veterans website at https://www.reynolds.edu/student_services/veterans/forms.aspx. By submitting your RFC, it informs us that you would like to use your benefits for the spring 2021 session. If your chapter/benefit is eligible we will place an indicator on your account which holds your classes until we receive payment from the VA. If your chapter/benefit is not eligible you must pay out of pocket or pay your percentage by the established deadline for your classes to be held.

When registering for classes please remember the course modalities/formats

You will need one in person class to receive your full housing allowance

In person: All instructional hours are taught in person, face-to-face. (PR, DT, GC, TK)

Traditional Online: Instruction hours are delivered online without any specific scheduled class meeting time. (OA)

Live Online: Instructional hours in real-time online through live video conferencing. (LO)

Online Hybrid: Instructional hours delivered online through a combination of live and traditional online format meetings. (HO)

Hybrid in-person/Live online: 50-99% of instructional hours delivered live, online and remaining instructional hours are in person, face-to-face. (LP, LD, LG, LK)

Hybrid In-Person/Traditional online: 50-99% of instructional hours delivered in traditional online format and remaining instructional hours are delivered face-to-face. (HP, HD, HG, LK)
