Post 9/11 GI Bill®

Enrollment verification is a new requirement for Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33) students to verify every month that you are still enrolled in the same courses or training that your school certified to VA. **It’s not about verifying that you are attending classes**, but whether your certified enrollment has changed. This will start in spring 2022.

You will receive a text from one of the following numbers to verify your enrollment:

You can also verify your enrollment using the following number 888-442-4551.

If you do not verify your enrollment the following will happen:

If you fail to submit enrollment verification for two consecutive months, your MHA/kicker payments will be held until you verify your enrollment. For example, if your term starts on January 10, 2022, and you fail to verify your enrollment for January and February, your March 2022 payments will be placed on hold.

Spring 2022 Registration is Open

Open Registration for spring 2022 session opened, Monday, November 1, 2021 and classes start Monday, January 10, 2022. After you register for spring 2022 classes please submit your Request for Certification (RFC) as soon as possible. Please see link <https://rfc.reynolds.edu/public/>.

By submitting your RFC, it informs us that you would like to use your benefits for the spring 2022 session. Please read the terms listed on the RFC before you hit submit. Requests for Certifications are processed in the order they are received.
